

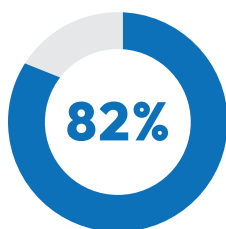


# Smoke-Free Trinity

**82% of Trinity residents were supportive**

### Trinity Resident Quotes

- “ I am very supportive as I was a victim of secondhand smoke when I was a kid. That caused me to have lung issues and asthma.
- “ I attend little league games and I don't think people should smoke around children.
- “ People do have a right to smoke but I think they should not do it where children are present or in general public areas while events are going on. Or have a designated area away from the general public.

The top three areas of information were most important when considering support for a smoke-free policy:

**56%**

Information on the risks of secondhand smoke exposure to young children, elders and pets

**36%**

Information on proper disposal of commercial tobacco product waste

**33%**

Information on smoking prevalence in my community
